CIVIL JUDICIAL TEST

1) The following are the subjects of the Tests:-

1. The code of civil procedure and the rules of practice (Civil) of the High Court of Judicature at Madras on the Appellate Side and the Courts Subordinate thereto as revised up-to date.
2. The government desire that the examination should be a practical Test of an Officer's acquaintance with and understanding of the ~~maxims~~ codes and text books prescribed and the question papers should be so framed as to secure this object.

II) The examination in the civil rules of practice is not to be confined to the schedules appended to Revised civil Procedure Code. (G.O.NO.2260 Home (Judicial) dated 5 th October 1918.)

The paper on the detailed application in the civil procedure code and the civil rules of practice should be a real test of the candidate's Knowledge of these subjects especially by the civil rules of practice (G.O.Ms-No.1346, Public (Service), dated 16th August 1935).
