- c) Minerology
- d) Economic Geology with special reference to Indian Mineral ore Deposits, Origin, Distribution, Utilisation of Metallic Non-Metallic and industrial mineral deposits of India.
- e) Principles of prospecting and estimation of ore reserves.
- f) Petrology
 - i) Different Rock types;
 - ii) Classification of rocks;
