(1) SYLLABUS

1. The Andhra Pradesh Inspection Code with special reference to the Office and the General duties of Deputy Inspectors.
2. The Andhra Pradesh Educational Rules, the Andhra Pradesh Elementary Education Act, 1920 with Rules made thereunder, important Government Notifications relating to Education and the Sections of the Andhra Pradesh District Municipalities Act, 1920 and the Andhra Pradesh Local Boards Act, 1920, relating to Education and the Bye-Laws and Rules issued thereunder. (Vide G.O.Ms.No:554, dt:9-8-1974).
3. Grant-in-aid Code and the Rules for the grant of recognition and Aid to Elementary Schools and the Educational Statistics and the rules relating to the provident Fund for Teachers in non-pensionable service:

NOTE:- (1) Candidates are required to be conversant with such amendments to the Acts, Rules etc., mentioned above as might have been issued or published not later than six months prior to the date of the examination.

(2) Candidates will be permitted to use the Public Instruction report and the Census Statistics in answering the question on the Educational statistics.
