 - 3) A study of model bye-laws of the regulated markets
- III. Grading and Standardisation Detailed study of the
 - 1) Agricultural Produce grading and Marketing Act, 1937
 - 2) The General Grading and Marketing Rules 1937 made
 - 3) A detailed study of the Grade Designations and definitions of quality prescribed under the Grading and Marketing rules for the Major important Agricultural Commodities and livestock produce viz., Rice, Tobbacco, Ghee, Jaggery, Groundnut, Jute, Turmeric, Chillies and other commodities like. Citrus fruits, eggs, mangoes for selected varieties, cotton, vegetable oils and cakes, cashew, pulses, onions, palmyrah fibres.
